

Landscape – Drawing and Painting

Basic sketching materials:

Sketch Book , some pencils. Note pad and pen or pencil to take note.

Canadian Landscape Photo Reference of your choice

Palette (board or with wells) and palette knife, Paper towels, Spray bottle, Masking tape

Special items: have a shallow box with lid (could close tightly). Sponge sheet big enough to fit in the box. Disposable Palette paper from art store.

Acrylic Color set with Basic palette or any starter set

2 Blue –French Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean Blue,

2 Red - Alizarin Crimson, Cadmium Red,

2 Yellow - Cadmium Yellow, Lemon Yellow

Raw or Burnt Sienna,

Raw or Burnt Umber,

Yellow Ochre

Acrylic add Titanium White

Canvas or canvas board/ Panels

2 canvas, Size 9"x11"

Or heavy weight paper for acrylic.

Need some heavy weight paper for testing and color concept

Brushes

White bristles flat brushes, size 3, 5 and 10.

Soft, synthetic brushes Flat or Filbert, Size 1, 3 and 5

Drawing & Painting Floral in watercolor

Paper

At least 90lb, 140 lb will be good choice ,

Size: Watercolor paper Block, book not smaller than 9"x 11" , 4 pieces

¼ Sheet, Buy one sheet and cut into 4,

Need some smaller piece for color testing and color concept.

Color (Winsor Newston, DaVinci or any quality brand)

2 Red Alizarin Crimson and Cadmium Red

2 blue French Ultramarine Blue and Cerulean Blue

2 Yellow Cadmium Yellow (Winsor Yellow/Aureolin or Gamboge) and Lemon Yellow

Raw Sienna

Raw Umber

Ochre

Sap Green or Hookers Green

Indigo or Prussian Blue

Rose Madder or Permanent Rose

Brushes (recommend not to buy camel hair, hair come off easily)

Synthetic Round Size #1 and #3

Flat or Filbert or Angled, Size ¾ inche, and ½ inches or ¾ inch and 1 inch

Prefer at least one Angled flat brush.

Rigger #0 or #1

Others

Sketch book and pencil, Kneaded eraser and white nylon eraser

Support Board, Masking tape, spray bottles, paper towels.

Containers for holding water, wash brushes (2 small 8 oz + 1 large 700 g yogurt cup).

Individual mixing palettes (with wells) for water color.
