(most items available at DeSerres Art Store)

- Set of 24 (or more) Prismacolor Premier Coloured Pencils (not their Verithin ones)
- Prismacolor Premier Coloured Pencil – “Indigo Blue” (BPC901) if not in your set
- Prismacolor Premier “Colorless Blender” pencil (not the Derwent brand one)
- 1 Derwent drawing pencil – “Chinese White”
- 1 Polychromos coloured pencil “Black”
- 1 Polychromos coloured pencil “White”
- Various primary-colour Polychromos pencils if your budget allows (optional)
- 1 sheet 140lb hot-pressed extra-white Fabriano watercolour paper
- 1 sheet Stonehenge White paper (C110 at DeSerres - \$4.29)
- Sandpaper pad sharpener (Mars Staedtler or DeSerres brand)
- Synthetic hog hair bristle angle or filbert paintbrush (size 6, 8 or 10) OR old oil painting brush
- Inexpensive synthetic Taklon round or filbert soft brush (size 6, 8 or 10)
- Touch Double-tip Blender Marker OR any alcohol-based colourless blender marker
- 2 or 3 medium size paper blending stumps
- Duck Brand Removable Mounting Poster Putty (available at Amazon OR a new kneadable eraser)
- 2-hole metal pencil sharpener
- 11” x 14” masonite-type board (\$1.99 at DeSerres)
- Metal Shield for erasing (\$1.79 at DeSerres S52950)
- Mono Zero Eraser Pen (or any mechanical pen eraser)
- Black eraser (Factis brand is best)
- Battery-operated eraser (optional)
