

Bruce Outridge Pen & Ink Class Material List

First Class Requirements:

The list below is a suggested list of materials. In the first class I will be going over the different materials so you may want to hold off buying many materials until after that.

For the first class please have the following:

Paper for drawing, pencil, eraser, and a technical pen. The rest you may want to wait until we discuss to purchase. If you already have those materials, feel free to bring them along.

Paper Suggestions:

Smooth Bristol Paper works best
Preferably 100lb or better, 8x10 or larger

Pencils and Erasers:

Pencil set or pencils. (I suggest 2H pencils)
Kneaded eraser

Technical Pens:

Any acid free technical pen is good. I suggest the Pigma Micron pens, these are pens with very fine tips. Faber Castel or Copic are other good brands. Cost around \$3.00 each

The tips come in a variety of sizes, I suggest 08, 05, 01

Dip Pens:

A dipping pen is used with liquid ink. Buy the package with a few different nibs and a holder for around \$10.

A small watercolour brush is suggested as well

Liquid Ink:

A small bottle of india ink in black will cost around \$5.00. get the waterproof type if possible. I suggest black but they come in many colours so you are welcome to choose a colour you like.

Other Materials:

Portfolio case for finished artwork
Pictures of subject matter of interest
Rulers, other paper choices.
