

## **Abstract and Intuitive Painting – Choice of Medium with Carolyn Hassard**

### **Materials List**

Plastic table cover

18" x 24" mixed media pad ( Canson's, for example) and / or comparable, inexpensive canvasses ( 12" x 13" or 16" x 20") or panels

If paper is your choice (it's mine) get Gator board or plywood sheet or purple Styrofoam board from Home Depot to pin or tape paper to. It's also possible to choose cut canvas (Fabricland - if that's your choice, you know what to do.)

Applicators (You can choose: brushes, gloves if you're using your fingers, pieces of foam, sponge...)

2 Water containers. Yogurt tubs are great.

Artist's Quality Acrylic Paint: Whatever colours you have is fine.  
If you're buying, buy red, blue, yellow, burnt umber, white

One container heavy gel medium if using paper. Otherwise, Acrylic Gloss Medium (You won't need it on the first day. Wait, and arrange to share a bottle between 2 or 3 people. It's expensive. You might opt out. Medium on collage day will be provided.)

Mark making media like pastels, crayons or charcoal

Scissors

Collage Materials for Week 3; just found paper.

Eventual, fun option: wood panels for mounting. (Currys, Michaels, deSerres or Dollar Store)
