Supplies

Suggested list - Bring whatever supplies that you have but make sure that you have artist's quality paint.

Brushes (Synthetic)

1" flat

#6 round

#3 round

#1 round

Paint (I use Winsor and Newton, but any artist quality paint will do) NB. Don't buy Cotman

Aureolin Yellow

Permanent Alizarin Crimson (NB. It must say permanent, otherwise it will fade)

Prussian Blue

Cobalt Blue

Burnt Sienna

Neutral Tint

Other

1 sheet (30"x22") 140lb cold press paper (Arches)

Inexpensive watercolour pad (Canson XL watercolour pad is the best)

White watercolour palette (with 6 or more small sections and at least 3 larger sections)

12" x 16" board and Gummed Paper tape (Or Watercolour Art Board from deSerres)

HB or 2H pencil

Sketchbook

Masking tape

Paper towel

2 containers for water (large yogurt containers work well)

Small water spray bottle (dollar store)

Plastic tablecloth (dollar store)

Kneaded eraser
