**“INTRODUCTION TO PAINTING USING WATER SOLUBLE OIL/ ACRYLIC PAINTS”**

***Water soluble oil paint (approx 37ml tubes) (I use Winsor & Newton) OR Acrylics (I use Winsor and Newton Galleria):***

**2 Blues** (Ultramarine and Pthalo)

**2 Reds** (Cadmium Red Medium and Alizarin Crimson)

**2 Yellows** (Cadmium Yellow Light and Ochre)

**2 Earth Colours** : Raw Umber and Burnt Umber

**Zinc or Titanium White**

**Medium for water mixable oil paints.**

The Cadmium colours are more expensive - but if you get a 'hue' (on the label) - which is a synthetic base, you'll save money.

Sketch pad or Paper, pencils or charcoal (for drawing thumbnail sketches)

7X9 (approx) inch canvas panels : 3 panels

Canvas : We do not need this for the first 3 classes.

Size 6 filbert brush Size 2 filbert brush (good quality)

Palette pad

Palette knife for mixing paint

Rags (T-shirt material or old T-shirts) or Kitchen Paper towels.
