

**Oakville Art Society Juried Show, June 8 – June 17 2018,  
to be held at Oakville Gallery, Centennial Square**

**INFORMATION SHEET**

This show is open to OAS members.

Media: Paintings, Drawings, Photography, Mixed-media, sculpture. No reproductions such as giclee or copies of other artists work will be accepted. All work must be original and must have been completed in the past 3 years. Artists may submit one or two pieces, which will be juried by an experienced Juror. One, two or none of the works may be selected.

**Submissions must be received by the office by 1 p.m. on May 18 2018.**

Images of the art must be sent electronically: jpg, 300 DPI, labelled with artist name, artwork name, medium and size (width and height). Images should be sent to [info@oakvilleartsociety.com](mailto:info@oakvilleartsociety.com)

Fees: \$30 for up to two pieces. Fees are non-refundable. Fees can be paid by cash, cheque, online <https://quickclick.com/r/x3xod> or Pay Pal.

Your Application form (attached) may be sent electronically or dropped off in person or sent by mail.

**The Juror will select the work by May 25 at 5 pm. Artists will be notified on May 28 by email.**

**Drop off of selected work at Centennial Gallery on Thursday, June 7, between 10 and 12 a.m.**

Work must be professionally presented and, if 2D, ready to hang. Poorly wired frames or wet work will not be accepted at the drop off. Place labels (see attached) on the front and back of each 2D artwork, on the bottom of 3D work.

**Reception will be held on Monday June 11, 7 pm – 9 pm.** The reception will start with a presentation by the Juror, followed by the presentation of the awards and refreshments.

All work must stay in the show until it closes on Sunday, June 17 at 3:00 pm.

**Pick up of unsold work following show: June 17, 3:00 pm – 4:00 pm** at Oakville Gallery, Centennial Square. There is a \$10 a day charge for each work not picked up on time as it will have to be moved and stored at the OAS.

Insurance: all work is insured while on display at the Gallery.

Artists will be expected to volunteer by sitting the show.
