He has unique painting methods; He uses an elaborate system of layers of transparent and translucent paint, as well as a variety of texture that create an enticing tactile quality.

Luminosity, color intensity, and mastering the transparent and translucent techniques of glazes and veils will be emphasized. This workshop is for experienced beginners to advanced artists.


