Water soluble oil paint (approx 37ml tubes) (I use Winsor & Newton):

2 Blues (Ultramarine and Pthalo)

2 Reds (Cadmium Red Medium and Alizarin Crimson)

2 Yellows (Cadmium Yellow Light and Ochre)

2 Earth Colours : Raw Umber and Burnt Umber

Zinc or Titanium White

Medium for water mixable oil paints.

The Cadmium colours are more expensive - but if you get a 'hue' (on the label) - which is a synthetic base, you'll save money.

7X9 (approx) inch canvas panels (atleast 3)

Canvas 16X20 inch or bigger size : We do not need this for the first 3 classes.

Size 6 filbert brush Size 2 filbert brush (good quality)

Palette pad

Palette knife for mixing paint

Rags (T-shirt material or old T-shirts) or Kitchen Paper towels.
