

## WATERCOLOUR PAINTING MATERIAL LIST and optional materials for mixed medium

Please bring:

Artist Quality Paints of choice

- minimum palette (**permanent rose, cobalt blue & aureolin yellow**)
- if possible 6 or more colours that equal (**2 reds, 2 yellows, 2 blues**)

**Suggested Colours:** Please Note: You are invited to bring the colours that you always use, or want to learn to use.

New Gamboge or Indian Yellow	French Ultramarine	Opera

**BRUSHES OF CHOICE** Suggested sizes:

- 2" Robert Simmons white-sable-skyflow wash - *optional*
- 1" flat gold sable-clear hand, beveled end
- #5 & #8 round gold sable
- #3 or #4 rigger
- #16 (½" x ½") flat gold sable - *optional*
- 2" hake

**PAPER:** good quality 100% rag paper 140 lb and/or 300 lb (hot) smooth and cold press

board if paper is in sheets, and if not, blocks are suggested

**PALETTE:** (Robert E Woods or John Pike or equivalent) – scrub each paint compartment (not mixing areas) with an SOS pad to rough up the surface so that the paint will stick

**EXTRAS:**

- 2 plastic containers (500 ml)
- Eraser
- Tissues (Kleenex) a box is great!
- HB or 6B pencils
- Masking tape and masking fluid
- Small natural silk sponge (Curry's or Shopper's)
- Sketch book
- Ruler or set square for drawing
- Plastic table cover
- Optional: Music CD

Reference materials(books/photos)-the instructor will have available various subject matter colour references for \$1 per colour or you can bring your own.

## **Optional materials for mixed medium**

**Suggested materials for mixed medium to be used with watercolour. Students may choose any of these to try. Not all need be purchased**

- Artist quality gouache –black and or white
- Black India ink
- Ink pen with nibs or artist quality automatic pens (i.e. faber castell)
- Pastels-either chalk or oil
- Wax resist
