

Creating Wonders in Your Art with Paper Collage with instructor Joanna Turlej

Supply list:

- 2 canvases - 12"x16"
- 7-10 repurposed, good quality magazines – LCBO magazines and fashion magazines are the best with large sheets of coloured pages
- A pad of paper from an art store - **Mixed Media Canson 9"x12", 98lb, 60 sheets**. The cover is blue with large XL in a black square. (Please no substitutes)
- 2 sheets of **good quality** Japanese tissue paper – one white, another of different, light colour, both with slight texture, DeSerres carries it, or The Japanese Paper Place <https://www.japanesepaperplace.com>
- Newspapers, or newsprint pad for drying painted papers
- **Good quality acrylic paints** - tubes, or liquid bottles - a basic set of colours: white, black, Lemon Yellow, Ultramarine Blue, Cadmium red, Quinacridone Red, and Phthalo Green. If you have other colours bring them along.
- A bottle of Matte Acrylic Medium 946 ml and a smaller bottle of Gloss Acrylic Medium
- Brushes: 1 - 1" bristle brush, 1 - 1/4" bristle brush for gluing, 1- 1.5" sable for painting
- 1 pencil B softness, 1 white pastel pencil and 1 black pastel (or charcoal) pencils for tracing
- Ball-point pen to trace
- Scissors (1 small and 1 large) and utility knife or X-Acto knife for cutting
- Small cutting board, if you have one
- A roll of tracing paper
- 2 rolls of paper towel
- Masking tape, 12" ruler, erasers (white and kneaded), 2 water containers (example: 750 g yogurt container)
- Large water spray bottle with a fine spray nozzle (Dollar store)
- 2 jam jars for acrylic mediums
- Few meat trays for mixing paint, those with small edge
- Medical gloves (optional, if you prefer clean hands)
- Sturdy board, example size 28"x36". Can be foamcore or cardboard. It is best covered with plastic for drying papers.
- A dozen of large size paper yellow bags (Dollar store), or plastic (Staples) for storage of your papers
- Pen and notebook
