MATERIALS:

- small palette knife (diamond shape) - metal with crook handle
- small brush to sketch design on canvas/panel (you may also use charcoal, or chalk if you prefer)
- 11x14" masonite or wood panel, primed and painted pink, red or orange
- wet palette
- grey palette paper
- paper towels
- table easel if you prefer

I will be using an assortment of Golden Heavy Body Acrylics but other brands are fine.

You are welcome to use the colours you have as long as you have a good selection (warm/cool of each primary, few neutrals, warm and cool white, couple of darks)

Neutral Gray (can be mixed)

Light Ultramarine Blue (can be mixed)
Ultramarine
Raw Sienna
Cadmium Yellow Medium
C.P. Cadmium Orange

Quinacridone Nickel Gold Azo
Dioxazine Purple
Cobalt Green
Pyrrole Red
