

SUPPLY LIST FOR ACRYLICS with MARIANNE BROOME

PAINTS

I use mostly soft body (Liquitex). If I need a particular colour that is not available in soft body I use heavy body (Liquitex, Golden, Winsor and Newton) and also use some fluids (Golden). The following colours will be required, **(L)** for landscapes only, **(F)** for florals only

Essential colours:

- Quinacradone Crimson or Acra Crimson
- Quinacradone Magenta or Acra Magenta or Quinacradone Violet **(F)**
- Cadmium Red Medium
- Cadmium Yellow Medium
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cobalt Blue
- Hookers Green or Jenkins Green **(L)**
- Cadmium Orange
- Burnt Sienna
- Raw Sienna or Yellow Ochre
- Dioxazine Purple **(F)**
- Titanium White

Optional colours:

- Cadmium Yellow Light or Azo Yellow
- Burnt Umber **(L)**
- Olive Green (can be mixed from black and yellow)
- Cerulean Blue **(L)**
- Prussian Blue or Indathrine Blue or Anthraquinine Blue
- Sap Green
- Quinacradone Nickel Azo Gold
- Quinacradone Burnt Orange **(L)**
- Naples yellow **(L)**
- Unbleached Titanium White **(F)**

MEDIUM

Acrylic Matte Medium – **liquid**, not gel. Any other mediums that you like working with.

SUPPORT

Primed stretched canvas, canvas board or primed masonite. Suggested size 16x20 or 20x24 or a square canvas for florals. Larger size if you like to paint bigger.

BRUSHES

Synthetic acrylic brushes, **not bristle** oil painting brushes.

- Essential** is a 2 inch flat (or at least 1 1/2 inch)
- 1/2", 3/4", 1" brights (short flat)
- No 4 or 6 round
- No 4 or 6 rigger
- Optional – 1/4 " bright and Filberts (oval) - I use nos. 8, 10 and 14 **(F)**

PALETTE

Acrylic stay wet palette OR plastic peel off palette or paper plates with cling wrap to cover.

OTHER

- Smock or apron and wear painting clothes!
- Plastic container for water, 500 ml or larger
- Paper towel and piece of old towel/rag or shop cloths
- Plastic sheet to protect table
- Fine mist spray bottle
- Palette knives (plastic ones are fine)
- Small sketchbook or scrap white paper, notebook, pen and pencil
- Water-soluble pencils or blackboard chalk
- Photos to work from if you wish. Reference pictures will be supplied
- Table easel, if you like to work upright
