Materials List

Plastic table cover

Inexpensive canvasses (12" x 13" or 16" x 20") or panels

Applicators (You can choose: brushes, gloves if you're using your fingers, pieces of foam, sponge...)

2 Water containers. Yogurt tubs are great.

Artist's Quality Acrylic Paint: Whatever colours you have is fine.
If you're buying, buy red, blue, yellow, burnt umber, white

One container heavy gel medium if using paper. Otherwise, Acrylic Gloss Medium (You won't need it on the first day. Wait, and arrange to share a bottle between 2 or 3 people. It's expensive. You might opt out.)

Mark making media like pastels, crayons or charcoal

Scissors

Eventual, fun option: wood panels for mounting. (Currys, Michaels, deSerres or Dollar Store)
