

# Watercolor Beginner with Diana Lee

## Paper

Watercolor paper, 90lb to 140lb, blocks or pad

Any size will work

## Colors Platelet (Winsor Newton, DaVinci or any quality brand)

1 or 2 each of Red, Blue, Yellow (we can mix our own green, orange and violet)

Red (Alizarin Crimson **AND/OR** Cadmium Red)

Blue (French Ultramarine Blue **AND/OR** Cerulean Blue)

Yellow (Cadmium Yellow, Winsor Yellow, Aureolin, Gamboge **AND/OR** Lemon Yellow)

2 Earth color (RAW Sienna, Burnt Umber)

Handy color (option)            Sap Green **OR** Hookers Green

Great for flower (option)      Rose Madder **OR** Permanent Rose

Brushes (recommend not to buy camel hair brushes, hair come off easily)

3 Synthetic or natural hair **Round** brush : Size #1 , #3, #6 or #8

**Flat** (or **Angled**) : ½ inches and 1 inch (recommend to have one Angled flat brush.)

Fine small brushes for line and details: **Rigger** #0 or #1

## Others

Sketch book and pencil, 1 Kneaded eraser and white nylon eraser

Support Board (at least 14"x 20"), Masking tape, spray bottles, paper towels.

Containers for holding water, wash brushes (yogurt cup or small containers).

Palettes with big area, wells to mix color ( some small dishes also work)
