

Materials List Painting from a Photograph – Acrylics with Instructor Julie Wurtele

Painting and creativity is part of us, I really believe that. As children we just dive in and try but somehow along the way we become fearful of mistakes. There are no mistakes in my class, only happy accidents. We will celebrate the “oopsies” and figure out together how we can take them from oops to awesome!

You will need:

Canvas 8 x 10 or larger

Acrylic paints:

- White
- Black
- Ultramarine blue
- Alizarin red
- Cadmium yellow
- Burnt umber
- And any other colour you wish to work with

Brushes:

- Filbert acrylic paint brush ($\frac{1}{4}$ inch or size 4 or 6)
- $\frac{3}{4}$ inch
- $\frac{1}{4}$ inch flat brush

Pencil

Eraser

Wet palette or paper plate (or something you usually put paints on)

Water container

Paper towels

Table cover
