

Supplies List for Colour and Values for Still Like Painting; Necessary Exercises in Water-soluble Oil or Acrylics with Instructor Wendy Pride

Notebook, pen

***Subjects:** You will need to purchase and bring 1 -8 (you can eat them later ☺)

1. A nice red field tomato
2. A green pepper
3. One or more lemons
4. A bunch of red/purple grapes or a bunch of strawberries.
5. An orange
6. A large whole garlic
7. A medium size onion with a good skin.
8. A boiled egg.

A large neutral cloth, tea towel, or napkin

A plate or bowl.

Paints: Water mixable oil or Acrylic Paint.

5 Essential Colours – please be sure to have these colours; there are no substitutions for them.

Titanium White
Cadmium yellow light (or hue)
Alizarin crimson
Cadmium red light
Ultramarine blue

Optional: Any other colours you may have.

Painting Knife pointed metal or plastic blade, Trowel shape. inverted handle. The diamond shaped blade will be about ½” wide by 1;5” long.

Brushes: One Bright (straight tip but shorter bristles than a flat), long handle; # 6 (about 1/2 “ across of bristles – sable or imitation is nice). *Because some makers numbers vary, look for the size ½” width for the bristle end width. And any of your favorites.

Canvas boards. You will need 6 to 8 panels in size 8 x 10” for the exercises. (dollar store quality is fine for the study panels). (no need for mounted canvas on frames)

Palette – have a good size *flat* mixing space. Tear off paper palettes are convenient. Putting foil over a cookie sheet will give a good size mixing space.

Colour Wheel A basic colour wheel can be purchased, or downloaded from the internet. Please bring one or a printed copy. We will discuss the colour wheel during any colour mixing exercises.

Stand Easel or Table top. (OAS has stand up easels)

Medium: optional – medium for water soluble oils or for acrylic as your preference. I do like Gamblin solvent free gel (great texture).

Brush cleaning jar or can

Towels/rags Roll of paper towels or box of facial tissue as preferred.

Plastic bag and tape for waste towels. Tape, clip or clothespin may be useful for placement.

Plastic table cloth cover for table, and one to protect vehicle

Brush container, case or box. Good brushes can be costly and you will want to protect them from damage.

Storage bin or bag for all your great stuff!
