

Discover the beauty of ink art in this hands-on, two-day workshop, where you'll learn to create stunning ink drawings using a variety of techniques. As a beginner artist, you'll gain the tools to develop your style and express yourself creatively through ink.

Day 1 (2 hours)

Building the Foundation of Ink Drawing

We begin by familiarizing ourselves with the materials and techniques that form the core of ink drawing. You will have the opportunity to practice these fundamental skills before applying them to your own work.

- **Materials and Tools**

- Ink Types
- Paper Types

- **Basic Drawing Techniques**

- Line Work: Practice creating precise, clean lines as the foundation of your drawing.
- Hatching & Cross-Hatching
- Stippling

- **Techniques for Different Effects**

- Negative Space
- Texture Creation
- Composition and Layout

- **Still life Composition Project**

To practice these techniques, we'll start with a still life subject. The composition will combine a glass bottle, scarf, flowers jar and fruits (a apples), and a curtain into a single scene. Using techniques like hatching, stippling, and line work, you'll explore textures, depth, and contrast, balancing both natural and man-made elements in your drawing.



Day 2 (2 hours)

- **One-Line Drawing**

Challenge yourself with the One-Line Drawing technique. This involves creating continuous, unbroken lines to represent a subject. We will create several illustrations using this technique.

- **Personal Projects**

In Session 2, you'll have the chance to work on a personal ink project, incorporating the techniques you've learned, where you will merge two objects in a serial way.

- **Student Work Showcase & Reflection**

At the end of the session, we'll have a chance to take a look at what everyone's worked on. It's a great way to see what your colleagues have created and get inspired by each other's ideas. Feel free to share your thoughts if you'd like, but it's also totally fine to just enjoy the show-and-tell!
