Material List

Please note that Demos will be done in Acrylic and recommended media is Acrylic. Materials can be purchased from Michaels or Currys or any other Art Supply store.

1. Paints

- Acrylic (Liquitex Basics is a preferable brand)
- Or, watercolors (Winsor Newton is a preferable brand); And basic set of Gouache.
- Or, Oil (Artisan water mixable oil)

List of colors: Primary Yellow, Primary Red, Primary Blue, Yellow Ochre, Alizarin Crimson, Orange, Viridian Green, Burnt Umber, Titanium White, Black

- 2. A few pencils, kneaded eraser
- 3. A palette (recommended is a Masterson Palette)
- 4. A Palette knife (Medium size trowel)
- 5. Brushes (size 0, 2, 4, 6, 8) Flats or Filberts brushes, a 1 inch Flat. Sable for watercolor, natural bristle for Acrylic and Oil.
- 6. Painting surface If using watercolor get a few good quality 300 gsm watercolor paper. If using acrylic or oil, get a pack of 9X 12 canvases (Boards or Stretched). A sketchbook.

7. Other supplies:

- A few cotton rags (old sheet or t-shirt cut into 8 X 8 pieces) or Blue shop towel
 (prefer cotton rags). Gloves (optional), A couple of small trash bags to carry away any discardable.
- A few little discardable plastic cups, a dropper, Mist bottle, a cup, a small bottle (plastic), A masking tape, An easel (small, foldable)
- Oil painters will need Artisan brand water mixable linseed oil.
- A folding easel for Acrylic or Oil Painters. A flat easel for watercolorist.
