## **Beginner Watercolour Materials List**

- 140 lb cold press watercolour paper. May use sheets or a book with paper in pressed pads (minimum 9 X 12 but 12 X 16 is better).
- Paints in tubes or pans. Try to buy <u>artist quality</u>, not student quality.

Lemon Yellow or Aureolin Yellow

Crimson, Scarlet or Ruby Red

Ultramarine Blue

Raw Umber

Bring any colours you already have

- A palette if you have one; if you don't, you can use an old saucer.
- Round watercolour brushes, sizes 10 and 2. I recommend two to start plus a standard Dollar Store paintbrush to put a wash on the paper. (Do not buy flat brushes).
- Pencil
- Eraser
  - Container for water old margarine tub, etc. (a cup is too small)
- Table cover- A white/clear plastic one from the dollar store is good
- Masking tape
