

Materials for 12x12x12 Abstracts

- Good quality acrylics paints
 - Golden, Tri-Art, Artist's Loft Academic or Professional grade, Windsor Newton or Amsterdam in 4 fl oz tubes minimum
 - look at whether it's transparent or opaque – don't get them all the same
 - You don't need heavy body paint but you can use it if you like
 - Liquitex can be problematic as it often contains too much medium relative to pigment – too slippery - but you can mix a few tubes in with better brands
- Twelve quality 12" x 12" boards (with paper mounted for watercolorists)
 - birch available at Home Depot is good; have it cut
 - masonite will do too
- Modelling Paste
- Mod Podge
- Paper and ephemera
- Markmaking tools like pencils, oil sticks (not pastels), and pens
