

## ***Intro to Colour Theory Materials List***

You may use watercolour, acrylic or oil\* for this class. The instructor will be demonstrating in acrylic, but all techniques and information is easily transferable.

Paint - you want your primaries as neutral as possible, meaning not too warm or too cool. We will talk about the differences in class.

- Primary Red
- Primary Yellow
- Primary Blue
- Titanium White
- Burnt Umber
- Payne's Grey

Surfaces:

- For watercolour: watercolour paper pad 9"x12"
- For acrylic or oil: canvas panels or canvas paper 9"x12" x8

Brushes:

- Small & medium brushes - can be round or flat

Palette:

- Watercolour palette OR
- Palette paper pad

Palette knife (for acrylic or oil)

Green painters tape

Water container

Table cover (ie: plastic table cloth, garbage bag)

Pencil & eraser
