In this six week introductory class you will learn the basics of digital art. Through instruction and hands-on learning, you will gain confidence in creating compelling compositions, use of colour theory, drawing and painting techniques with digital brushes, and exploring different ways to create texture and interesting effects.

Classes will start with colour theory and understanding tonal painting, and build upon those skills to create full colour pieces. We will be using a combination of still-life setups and photo references to learn from. Topics include still-life subjects of different materials, landscapes, and nature, just to name a few. Whether you are building up your skills or starting from the very beginning, the goal is to learn something new and have fun!

iPad or other tablet with drawing software - I will be using an iPad with the latest version of Procreate for demos and brushes, however if you already have a tablet and/ or program you prefer and are familiar with that is alright too as many of the techniques and theories discussed will work just the same.
